In 2017 Bradfield is being connected to mains drainage. This involves digging a trench from Bradfield by a complex route to Swafield. Given that a good signal is available up to 1km from a cabinet, if a fibre optic cable was laid into the same trench a huge area including Bradfield, Antingham and parts of outlying North Walsham could have decent internet speeds.
